These may also include cookies essential for fraud prevention measures. While you may configure your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, doing so may render certain parts of the Website inoperable.

2. **Enhanced Functionality Cookies:** These cookies augment the Website's performance and functionality but are not critical for its operation. They enable the Website to remember your preferences (e.g., username, language, region) and provide personalized features. They may also facilitate services you have requested, such as video playback or blog commenting. Information collected by these cookies may be

anonymized and cannot track your browsing activity on external websites.

3. **Analytical Performance Cookies:** These cookies gather data on visitor behavior, such as frequently visited pages and encountered error messages. They collect aggregated, anonymous information solely to improve website performance and understand user interactions. No personally identifiable information is collected through these cookies.

4. **Targeted Advertising Cookies:** These cookies deliver advertisements tailored to your interests based on your browsing history. They record your Website visits and share this information with third-party advertisers. Consequently, you may encounter customized advertisements on other websites. These cookies also limit ad repetition and measure advertising campaign effectiveness.

COOKIE MANAGEMENT AND USER RIGHTS

DATA RETENTION AND COOKIE PERSISTENCE

1. **Session Cookies:** These cookies persist only for the duration of the browsing session and are automatically deleted upon closing the browser.
2. **Persistent Cookies:** These cookies remain on the User's device until their predetermined expiration date or until manually deleted by the User.
